

## STANDING DOWN THE NET

Before standing down the net:

1. Have the Local Liaison contact District 2 and make sure that there is no further need to maintain local Net Operations. If you are acting as District 2 verify with NWS that the local net is no longer needed.
2. Check for any reports of significant weather or weather-related damage.

Close contact with District 2 or North Central Skywarn by formally signing out on the air with the Local Liaison. Close the Net by saying:

**This is (Callsign), Net Control for Cuyahoga County Skywarn. At this time we are standing down the Net. (Explain the current weather situation). I would like to take this opportunity to thank everyone that participated in the Net. Cuyahoga County Skywarn would also like to thank the Lake Erie Amateur Radio Association for the use of its repeaters. Please stand by so the repeater can be returned to normal operations. (Callsign)**

Key up, ID and enter the code (Code: \_\_\_\_\_) to return the repeater to normal.

NOTE: If conditions that require a Directed Severe Weather Net have dissipated or have passed, but such conditions are expected to return within one hour. Net Control should stand down the Directed Severe Weather Net to a Standby Weather Watch.
